Pennsylvania. Kirsty demonstrated drawing a bird with Pan Pastel base drawing and colored pencil rendering on top. Kirsty said that she prefers paper with some tooth. Also, the pastels can be mixed in the can or on the paper. She doesn't use fixative but that is a personal preference.
